Mixed - Hand building / Wheel Throwing techniques: All levels of experience from those experiencing for the first time or have some experience working with. Learn the basics of working with clay. Explore form and function through slab work, coil and pinch pots and forms, and surface treatments. Explore wedging, centering, and throwing forms from mugs, to bowls, plates, etc.

More advanced students will focus on throwing comfortably with more weight and constructing more complex forms. Finishing techniques as well as glazing and firing will also be covered. .
